IMISO CERAMICS

Imiso Ceramics is a celebrated South African ceramic studio rooted in African spirituality, heritage, and contemporary design. Co-founded by **Zizipho Poswa and Andile Dyalvane**, the studio creates powerful, handcrafted ceramic artworks that tell stories of identity, ancestry, and cultural pride. Zizipho's work is deeply inspired by African womanhood and traditional Xhosa hairstyles, while Andile draws from his rural upbringing in the Eastern Cape and the sacred language of scarification. Together, they transform clay into spiritual vessels that bridge the ancient with the modern, making Imiso Ceramics a must-see on our African Spiritual Tour.


